Five-year-old black cat | Cerebellar Hypoplasia (CH) | Two years in HOPE's care



The moment Casserole came through our doors, he stood out—not just for his severe CH, which caused him to wobble and lose his balance, but for his determination behind every shaky step.

He quickly became a legend at our Adoption Center. Staff created a safe space just for him and he'd roam the center each day, greeting volunteers and visitors in his wobbly way.

Casserole needed a rare kind of adopter-

someone patient, experienced, and ready to embrace his needs. *Because of supporters like you*, he had the time to wait. In October 2025, on his **two-year** anniversary, Casserole's adoption was finalized. He is now thriving in a home where his quirks are cherished and his spirit shines.

THE GOLDEN RETRIEVERS OF MILTON - A Rescue Rewritten

55 dogs seized | 6 placed with HOPE fosters | Countless lives changed







Earlier this year, authorities seized **55 neglected dogs** from a property in Milton, NY—54 Golden Retrievers and one tiny Chihuahua. Their state was heartbreaking: matted with feces, soaked in urine, trembling, hiding, and unsure of human touch.

HOPE volunteers stepped in immediately—armed with brushes, towels, patience, and compassion.

The dogs arrived in three waves, and many took **over an hour** to groom. Our team returned day after day because these dogs deserved a chance at safety, comfort, and love.

From this case, we welcomed **six dogs** into our foster program—each with a unique path to healing.

These six lives will never return to what they came from.
